THE makeristAR-ANCHOR

How it works

1



Print out the MakeristAR anchor. Turn off the automatic page adjustment of your printer and print the anchor as „actual size“. We recommend using slightly thicker printer paper.

Be sure to measure the printed anchor to make sure that it is actually 15x15cm/5.91x5.91" as indicated.

2



Cut out the anchor and make sure there are no creases or wrinkles.

3



Spread out your fabric and place your anchor on it. Make sure your fabric is laying flat, isn't warped, and doesn't have any wrinkles or creases. This is the only way to ensure the precise transfer of the individual pattern pieces.

4



Open the pattern you want to transfer in the MakeristAR app and hold your phone over the anchor. You can now align the pattern piece on the fabric by sliding the anchor on the fabric. If the anchor covers the outline of the pattern piece, you can adjust it's position via the arrows in the app.

5



Transfer the pattern with tailors chalk or a fabric pen. The best way to do this is to use small dashes or dots instead of solid lines.

15x15 cm/5.91x5.91"

Turn off the automatic page adjustment of your printer and print the anchor in „actual size“. Check the test square before you start the transfer.
